However in this engagement there were two additional companies (One from the 11th Reserve Jager Battalion and one from 146th Regiment) and each Battalion has been allocated an extra infantry stand to reflect these additional troops.

The number of fire missions has been cut to 5 (either as a single battery or brigaded) to reflect the smaller amount of ammunition carried by these smaller batteries.
- (4) The Germans launch their attack first. The Turkish troops can only arrive on table after a successful order change following the attempted capture or capture of any ANZAC entrenchment by the Germans. Order changes are rolled per regiment. This reflects the Turkish hesitation that occurred historically whilst taking part in this assault.
